

Geotechnical Technician

Job Overview:

North Island Mining Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of Northisle Copper and Gold Inc. is seeking a Geotechnical Technician to assist in exploration of the North Island Project located 35 Km West of Port Hardy BC. As a Geotechnical Technician, you will play a vital role in Northisle's exploration efforts, by collecting and documenting crucial structure data from diamond drill core. Geotechnical Technicians will be responsible for documenting core recovery, rock quality designation, weathering, hardness and breakage, among other information to the standards set by the Vice President, Exploration, in addition to moving and organizing core boxes, preparing samples for shipment, maintaining the Core Logging facilities and assisting geologists with assigned tasks as required.

About Us:

The North Island Project is currently focused on advancing the mineral resource deposits of Northwest Expo, Goodspeed, Hushamu and Red Dog with ongoing exploration on other targets within the 40 Km long highly prospective project area.

- Collect geotechnical data in compliance with the procedures and standards set out by the geologist.
- Handle and organize core samples and boxes to maintain the flow of materials into and out of the Core Cutting and Core Logging facilities.
- Communicate with the geologists to report progress, findings and incidents.
- Maintain accurate records of progress, material inventory and sample packing.
- Maintain and clean equipment within the Core Logging facilities.
- Complete all other tasks as assigned.

What you bring to the Role:

- Previous experience as a Geotechnical Technician is considered an asset.
- Previous experience working in mineral exploration or assay laboratories would be preferred.
- First Aid training is considered an asset.



Geotechnical Technician

- Mechanical knowledge for maintaining tools and machinery around the Core Logging facilities is an asset, but not required.
- Must be able to wear all PPE including but not limited to steel toe boots, hearing protection, gloves and eye protection for an extended period of time.
- Able to operate forklifts, side by side and pickup trucks in a safe manner is desirable. Training will be provided as needed.
- The ability to complete repetitive movements for long periods of time is required
- The ability to be proactive in identifying and mitigating or eliminating any observed potential hazards in the workplace is required
- The ability to work primarily in a standing position is required.
- The ability to work efficiently with computers and tablets is required.
- Reliable transportation to and from Port Hardy on a daily basis to the Company's site office is required. Transportation will be provided to any alternative work sites by the Company.

Education and Skills:

- A high school diploma is considered an asset.
- The ability to work and communicate effectively within a team setting is an asset.
- Strong written and oral communication is desirable.
- The ability lift and carry up to 25 kg (50 lbs) repetitively is required.
- A driver's license is considered an asset
- A strong outlook for the safety of others and yourself is required.
- The ability to work independently is required, however the site will have other employees present should assistance be needed.
