We are seeking a Senior Geological Field Technician to join our team reporting directly to the Exploration Manager. This is a hands-on role supporting mineral exploration programs through prospecting, access scouting, remote sensing, and on-site safety leadership. The ideal candidate has strong field experience, thrives in remote environments, and brings a safety-first mindset while excelling in collaborative team settings.

What You'll Do

- Prospect for mineralization and conduct reconnaissance sampling (rock, soil, stream sediment) to support target generation.
- Scout and assess access routes, drill pad locations, and helicopter landing zones.
- Assist in identifying opportunities within the regional program and in gathering the information necessary to support those opportunities.
- Serve as the Safety Warden and in-house safety trainer for a remote site, leading toolbox talks, maintaining documentation, and mentoring staff in safe work practices in remote circumstances.
- Support logistics: vehicle/ATV operation, camp moves, traverse plan assessment, and field equipment management.
- Act as lead first aid officer and coordinate emergency response when needed.
- Support on-site logistics when necessary, through construction or maintenance of site infrastructure

- 3+ years of exploration or equivalent remote work experience.
- Proven prospecting and field sampling skills with good QA/QC understanding.
- Strong safety background (OFA-2/3 or Wilderness First Aid required; WHMIS, ATV/UTV instructor, chainsaw safety an asset).
- Comfortable navigating in rugged, remote terrain.
- Experience working in BC regulatory environment highly regarded and permitting and site safety oversight experience an asset.
- Mine Supervisor certification is an asset.
