POSITION SUMMARY

We are seeking a Field Assistant to join our team, reporting directly to the Senior Exploration Geologist and directly supporting the Field Geologist. This role will contribute to the execution of our exploration programs across a worldclass porphyry copper-gold district. The Field Assistant will assist the Geologists in documenting coordinates, sample type, descriptions of samples, soil horizons, data collection and logistical support for our multi drill rig programs and play a role in advancing our technical understanding of the property's prospects and deposits. The ideal candidate thrives in remote environments and brings a safety-first mindset while excelling in collaborative team settings.

LOCATION

The Field Geologist will work a 14 day on, 14 day off rotation in Port Hardy, BC.

WHAT YOU BRING TO THE ROLE

- Previous experience as a Field Assistant or similar is considered an asset.
- First Aid training is considered an asset but will be provided where required
- Mechanical knowledge for maintaining tools, vehicles and side by sides is considered an asset, but not required.
- Experience working with or around helicopters is considered an asset.
- Experience driving 4x4 vehicles and side by sides on forest service roads in a variety of conditions is considered an asset.
- Experience and training operating chainsaws is considered an asset.
- The ability to hike with a heavy backpack for up to 8 hours in a variety of conditions.
- The ability to work in rainy, wet and muddy conditions.
- The ability to be proactive in identifying and mitigating or eliminating any observed potential hazards in the workplace.
- Previous knowledge or training in Geology is considered an asset.
- The ability to work efficiently with computers and tablets.
- Reliable transportation to and from Port Hardy on a daily basis. Transportation will be provided from the Company's Port Hardy office to the daily work sites.
