We are seeking Field Geologists to join our team, reporting directly to the Senior Exploration Geologists. This role will contribute to the execution of our exploration programs across a worldclass porphyry copper-gold district. The Field Geologist will support field programs with multiple crews and contractors, and play a key role in advancing our technical understanding of the property's prospects and deposits. The ideal candidate thrives in remote environments, and brings a safety-first mindset while excelling in collaborative team settings.

The Field Geologist will work a 14 day on, 14 day off rotation in Port Hardy, BC.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinate and support field programs including geological mapping, geophysics, soil/stream sediment sampling, and prospecting.
- Collaborate and contribute to deposit and district-scale geological models (lithology, structure, alteration, mineralization).
- Analyze and interpret varied datasets to generate and prioritize exploration targets.
- Ensure best-practice standards for data collection, management, and QA/QC are implemented and maintained.
- Assist in preparation of technical reports, presentations, figures and updates for Exploration Manager and Vice President Exploration.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE & SKILLS
